

## Lesson 11: The Holy Spirit and Life

### Key Search Words - man, breath, spirit, life

God's Spirit also had a part in making man a living being.

Gen 1:26

Gen 2:7

Ok, let's go back to what we learned about Jesus: Jesus is God's Word, and the commands that God gave to create man and the earth were spoken words. If you hold up your hand in front of your mouth when you speak, what do you feel on your hand? **Breath!**

Breath is needed in order to speak words. Genesis 2:7 states that God "breathed" life into man and Genesis 1:26 states that we were made after His likeness, so that means God has breath, too. So is there a connection between "breath" and "spirit"?

Let's check **Strong's Hebrew and Greek Dictionaries** to find out the Hebrew definition. Bring up Gen 1:2 in the KJV+ Bible, and click on the green number associated with the word "**+**Spirit". The word "spirit" is "ruach" in the Strong Dictionary and the proper definition is "to blow" or "breathe"! Figuratively, "ruach" also means "life". So that means that **God's Spirit, His breath**, gave us physical life. We can conclude, then, that God's spoken Word and breath, which is **Jesus and the Holy Spirit working together**, created the form of man. Then man was given physical life by God's breath, the Holy Spirit.

If God were to take back His breath from us, then we would return to dust. We need the His Spirit in order to live!

Job 33:4

Joh 1:1-4

God and Jesus are One and in them they have the same Spirit of life (Holy Spirit) which they used to create us and give us life. So, this is how the three worked together as One to create us!
