

Lesson 6: What is sin and why did Jesus have to die?

Key Search Words - sin, disobey*, man, separation, death, Son, died, life

So, what is ⁺sin and why did Jesus have to die for our sins? Doing a search on the word "sin", the first mention of the word is found in the book of Genesis. The basic definition of sin that we see in the Bible is disobeying God by doing what we desire instead of what He has commanded us to do or not to do. This is first seen in the story of the serpent deceiving Eve, and in Adam and Eve's decision to eat the fruit despite what God had told them.

Sin leads to broken relationship, which is separation, and separation leads to death. Because Adam and Eve disobeyed God, their relationship with God was broken, and that broken relationship has been passed down to us.
