The prophecies that it contains, as they are fulfilled, are to be used to confirm that they have been truly produced by the Holy Spirit and that they are not fictionalized stories by men. Many prophecies in the Old Testament have already been fulfilled and are noted and confirmed in the New Testament.

Psa 111:1-4

God wanted His creation to remember how He created the world, the covenants He made with men, and the great works He did in the sight of men. He wanted these accounts to be passed down from generation to generation, so that all men would study them. He wanted us to know of His power, grace, compassion, and love. He wanted us to know how to have a relationship with Him and how to share His love with others. I show God that I love Him with all of my heart when I find pleasure in studying the Bible.

The Scriptures were also given to men by God for ⁺doctrine and to testify of Jesus, confirming His purpose to do God's will here on Earth.
