Heart#5 - A Royal Soldier seeks to know and love King Jesus.

Heart#6 - A Royal Soldier completely trusts and has faith in King Jesus!

Heart#7 - A Royal Soldier believes that King Jesus is their Savior, their Healer, their Deliverer, and their Friend.

Soul#1 - A Royal Soldier is in awe of King Jesus and praises Him everyday!

Soul#2 - A Royal Soldier sings to King Jesus openly, letting others hear their song.

Soul#3 - A Royal Soldier confesses to others that King Jesus is Lord of their life.

Soul#4 - A Royal Soldier clings to King Jesus for life.

Soul#5 - A Royal Soldier is personally protected by King Jesus.

Mind#1 - A Royal Soldier guards their mind and meditates on what pleases King Jesus.

Mind#2 - A Royal Soldier prays, waits, and commits to doing the will of King Jesus.

Mind#3 - A Royal Soldier stays on guard by constant prayer, going to King Jesus for all their needs.

Strength#1 - A Royal Soldier is committed to perform all that King Jesus commands in His covenant.

Strength#2 - A Royal Soldier runs from evil and lives like King Jesus!

Strength#3 - A Royal Soldier belongs to King Jesus and serves Him at all times.

Strength#4 - A Royal Soldier gives all that they possess to King Jesus!

Strength#5 - A Royal Soldier proclaims the Gospel of King Jesus!

This kind of love and devotion in a Royal Soldier's relationship with King Jesus is deeper than just a business or casual friendship. It is a **mystery** that we need to understand.
